

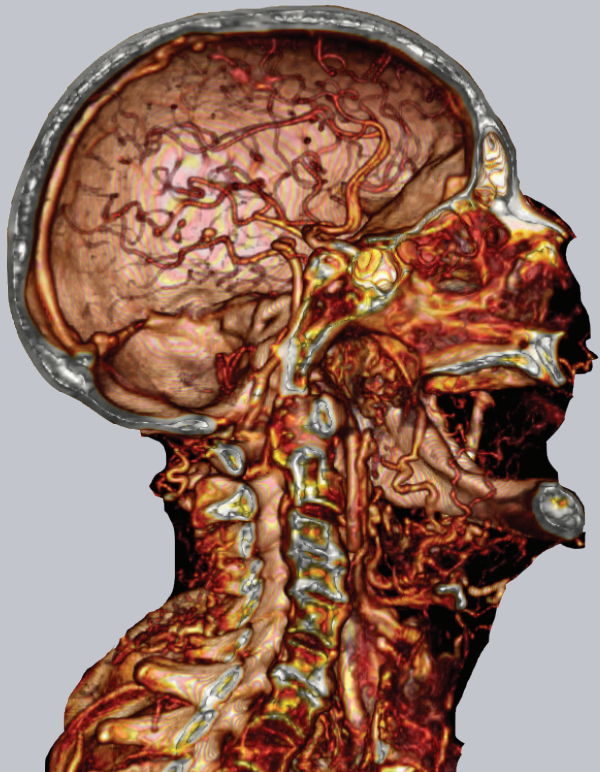

Short Modules and One Week Residential Courses in

Post Mortem Radiology

The University of Leicester's East Midlands Forensic Pathology Unit in partnership with the University Radiology Unit, are proud to provide the following short modules and one week residential:

1. Introduction to post mortem radiology
2. Practical aspects of post mortem radiology
3. Advanced post mortem radiology – adult natural death
4. Advanced post mortem radiology – adult unnatural death 1.
This focuses on asphyxia, blunt and penetrating trauma and thermal injury
5. Advanced post mortem radiology – adult unnatural death 2.
This focuses on mass fatality DVI, virtual anthropology and vehicle trauma.

Residential teaching courses 1-3 are accredited 30 Royal College of Pathologists (RCPath) and Royal College of Radiologists (RCR) CPD points. Residential teaching courses 4 and 5 are accredited 15 CPD points.
